BULLETIN INFORMATION

ARAB 121: Elementary Arabic (4 credit hours)

Course Description:

Grammar and practical vocabulary necessary for fundamental communication skills. Assumes no prior experience in the language. Offered only in fall.

SAMPLE COURSE OVERVIEW

Welcome to Arabic! This class will introduce the four fundamental language skills of Modern Standard Arabic (Fusha): reading, writing, comprehension and speaking. This class adopts a "proficiency-based" approach, which means we want you to get familiar with these four skills as soon as possible. Modern Standard Arabic is the language of literature and most forms of formal writing, news, business, scholarship, culture, and politics; it contrasts with spoken dialects of which every Arab country has their own. While Modern Standard Arabic is different from spoken colloquial Arabic, much of this vocabulary will be useful for both formal and colloquial languages. As in all language classes, participation, attendance, and homework are particularly important. Also, audio-video materials accompany the textbooks and you are expected to review them regularly. Prepared and in-class oral, written, comprehension, and reading skills will be practiced. In addition to the challenging mechanics of the language, Arab culture will also be introduced.

ITEMIZED LEARNING OUTCOMES

<u>Upon successful completion of Arabic 121, students will be able to:</u>

- 1. Communicate on a fundamental level orally and in writing, using the Arabic alphabet
- 2. Recognize, comprehend, and use basic Arabic vocabulary and grammatical concepts in simple sentences
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of society and daily life in the Arabic-speaking world.

SAMPLE REQUIRED TEXTS/SUGGESTED READINGS/MATERIALS

- 1. Alif Baa: introduction to letters and sounds (by Kristen Brustad, Mahmoud Al-Batal, and Abbas al- Tonsi, Georgetown University Press); along with CD and DVD 2011.
- Al-Kitab fi Ta'alhum al-'Arabiyya: A textbook for beginning Arabic, Part 1 ed, by Kirsten Brustad, Mahmoud Al Batal, and Abbas Al-Tonsi, Georgetown U. Press (2010), along with CD and DVD.

SAMPLE ASSIGNMENTS AND/OR EXAM

- 1. Tests: There will be Six (6) tests. The first test will cover the alphabet and other material in the Alif textbook. Subsequent tests will cover the material presented in each chapter in the al-Kitab textbook. Tests are designed to measure how well students have learned the vocabulary and grammar of the chapter. After you learn the alphabet and we start al-Kitab, every test will start off with a short original passage pertaining to the "story" (presented in each chapter). The passage will be followed by a series of questions, which you will answer in Arabic. This will test reading comprehension as well as your ability to write.
- **2. Quizzes:** Weekly **vocabulary quizzes** will be given. These quizzes will focus on the new vocabulary in the current unit but also review previous words.
- **3.** Homework & Participation: There will be daily written assignments due at the beginning of the next class period. Homework will assist you in mastering the vocabulary, grammar, reading, and comprehension lessons in the chapters and will review the class lesson. This is one of the principal ways for you to increase your aural skills and to develop your accent and proficiency verbally with the language.
- **4. Final Exam:** The final will be comprehensive. It will consist of a reading passage discussing the text's ongoing characters and "story." The exam will also have a listening comprehension component as well as sections on vocabulary, grammar, and cultural knowledge.
