



How to Apply as a Freshman

A freshman is a student who has never attended a regionally accredited college or university. Applicants who attended a postsecondary institution while still in high school are classified as freshmen, but must submit official transcripts of their college work (regardless of whether credit was or will be received).

- ✓ Complete the online application
- ✓ Requirements for admission:
 - Official high school transcript (mail to: **USC Lancaster Admissions, PO Box 889, Lancaster, SC 29721**)
 - If your high school provides electronic copies of transcripts, please make sure they are signed before being sent.
 - Official SAT or ACT test scores sent directly from the testing agency (CollegeBoard.org or ACTstudent.org) to USC Lancaster
 - Official test scores are only required if you are under the age of 21
 - Pay \$40 application fee or provide SAT/ACT fee waiver (please check with your high school guidance counselor if you are unsure of your eligibility for a fee waiver)
- ✓ Requirements for enrollment:
 - Immunization form and acceptable proof of immunization
 - Citizenship verification form and acceptable proof of citizenship
 - Proof of name change (if your name has changed at any time since birth and that name is listed on any transcripts, test scores, immunization records or citizenship documents)
- ✓ Admission
 - Once all required credentials have been submitted, your application will be reviewed and processed. You will receive notification of our decision by mail.
- ✓ Claiming Your Account
 - Your acceptance packet will include your VIP ID and a temporary password, along with instructions that you will need to follow in order to finish setting up your account.
- ✓ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - If you plan on receiving financial aid other than the LIFE scholarship, you will need to complete a FAFSA for USC Lancaster's campus, or add USCL to one you have previously submitted.

- ✓ Scholarships
 - USC Lancaster offers over 130 academic scholarships and we highly recommend that students submit a scholarship application, which can be found at
