**PASSPORTS – REQUIRED FOR EVERY TRAVELER**

In Lancaster County, you must go to Heath Springs Post Office on Main Street in Heath Springs, SC. You will need to bring: 2 passport-size photos (can be made at CVS pharmacy, AAA Auto Club, and elsewhere), a "State Seal" Birth Certificate and payment. Do this as soon as possible. If you are not an American citizen there may be deviations from the above information which may lengthen the time necessary to obtain the passport. The cost of a passport is approximately \$100.00.

**APPLICATION:** You may file a paper application by mail and enclose a check for the \$95 application fee or you may apply with a credit card on-line or by FAX (1-800-318-3732). The sooner you commit to the trip and apply, the more time you have to pay off the balance.

**COST – STUDENTS LESS THAN 25 YEARS OLD**

**\$2884.00**

Cost includes air-fare from/to Charlotte, 7 nights in hotels, breakfast and dinner daily; sight-seeing tours, visits to special attractions, and walking tours. **Payable:** \$95.00 at time of application [check or credit card] Balance due 99 days before departure date [for the mid-May departure, the **balance will be due by early February**]. Most students pay monthly installments toward their balance between registration and early February.

**REQUIRED** USC-L tuition for 3 credit hours. This is approximately **\$600.00. We are investigating the possibility of waiving course tuition.**

❖ If older than 25 or will turn 25 during trip add **\$322.00** for a total of **\$3219.00**; above pay schedule applies

**OTHER:** Spending money for lunches and souvenirs/gifts, optional all-inclusive insurance plan– [for health/medical, baggage/property, tour interruption, emergency assistance]; packing will be discussed in the upcoming months.
