Rationale for Proposed Revisions

- Codifying a practice that has been used for previous Manual Liaison Officers but has not been stated in the bylaws.

Summary of Proposed Revisions

- Adding a statement in the bylaws to allow the Manual Liaison Officer to receive one course release or course buyout per semester.

The officers of the Senate shall be a Chair, a Secretary, a Chair Elect or an Immediate Past Chair, possibly one or more Members-at-Large, and a Palmetto College Campuses Faculty Manual Liaison Officer, as well as such other officers as the Senate may from time to time establish. These officers shall perform the duties prescribed by the parliamentary authority and rules adopted by the Senate. The Secretary shall serve for a term of one year.
