OVERVIEW

Initially launched on October 1, 2018 (ending on October 31, 2018), *Human Relations Month*, is a month-long series of trainings, programs, and events designed to educate the University of South Carolina community about diversity, social justice, equality, and human relations.

GOAL

The goal of this month-long celebration is to saturate the University of South Carolina Community with information and educational opportunities pertaining to diversity, equality, and illegal discrimination/harassment. Faculty and staff will be required to complete a series of mandatory electronic educational courses and invited to attend a series of live training courses and forums.

THE OBJECTIVE

- #1: Launch mandatory faculty/staff diversity and inclusion training
- #2: Launch mandatory faculty/staff Illegal Discrimination and Harassment training
- #3: Offer a series of optional trainings and forums for faculty and staff.
- #4: Educate the University community in regard to proper reporting protocols, University policies, and human relationships and diversity skills.
