

USCL classes with a math placement prerequisite

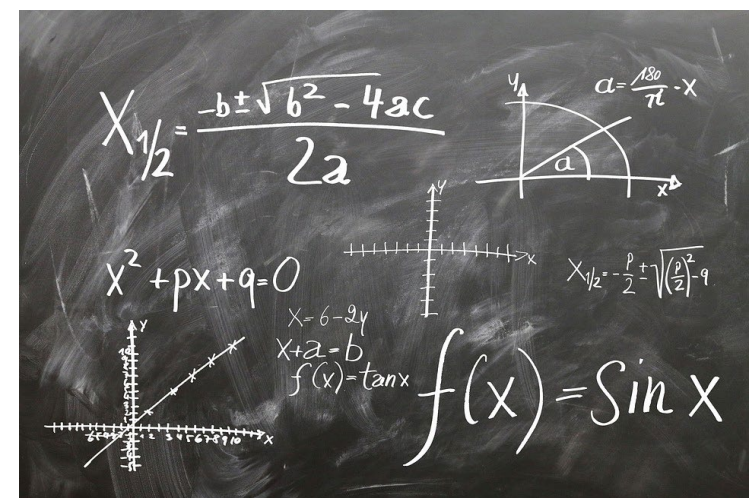
The table shows the minimum math prerequisites for USCL courses. You need either the listed MAP test score or the listed minimum grade in a prerequisite course. Courses with * have additional prerequisites. If you believe you qualify for a course without having the listed prerequisite, contact the course instructor. If you took a different math placement test, you may be required to take the MAP.

Do I need to take the Math Assessment of Prerequisite (MAP) Test?

Compare the required courses for your degree with the table of classes that have a math placement prerequisite.

- If you do not have prior coursework that meets the prerequisite, you are required to take the MAP to meet the prerequisite. Prior coursework may include transfer, AP, CLEP, and IB credit accepted by USCL.
- If you can meet the prerequisite through prior coursework, you do not need to take the MAP.
- If your prior coursework has not been posted to your account before your advisement appointment, you are encouraged to take the MAP.
- If you don't intend to take any courses with a math placement prerequisite, you may not need to take the MAP. Consult your advisor.

If you still are uncertain, take the MAP.

If you have questions or concerns about your prior coursework (transfer, AP or IB), contact the Office of Admissions and Records at uscladms@mailbox.sc.edu.

When and how do I take the MAP?

The MAP Test is available online in Blackboard, blackboard.sc.edu. You may take the MAP on or off the USCL campus.

To request access to the MAP, complete the online form at <https://forms.gle/ynFoB1ko5jYcHAd8A>

You are encouraged to take the MAP at least a week prior to your advising appointment. The test may take up to two hours. The test has three levels. If you answer 7 or more questions correctly on a level, the next level is unlocked.

Make sure your computer and Internet connection are reliable. If you do get disconnected, simply reconnect and continue your test.

When and how do I find the results of the MAP?

Your score will be reported immediately after completing the MAP. It can take up to two business days before your score is posted to your academic record.

Can I retake the MAP?

You are automatically allowed to take the MAP twice. The higher of those two scores will be recorded. You may also request to take the MAP a third time. If you do so, only your third score will be posted to your academic record.

How do I prepare for the MAP?

On Blackboard, take the MAP Tutorial to learn how to enter your answers in WebWork. Next take the MAP Practice Test to find out what types of questions you'll see on the MAP test. You may retake the tutorial and practice test until you feel prepared for the test.

Technical help

Access to the MAP is restricted to individuals with a valid USC network username and password. To find your username, and to reset the password, go to my.sc.edu, then click "Login and Password Help".
