Frequently Asked Questions

Prospective students often ask how long the **Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies** takes to complete, what the program costs and if financial aid is available, and if the degree is awarded through UofSC.

You can find answers to these questions below.

 Completion time varies based on already accumulated general education credits and courses necessary to complete the major concentration. The degree requires 120 credit hours. It is up to the student and advisor to decide the appropriate number of hours to take each semester.

Prepare for Your Future

The online UofSC Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies program prepares students for success in several critical study disciplines through a multidisciplinary program you will design with an experienced advisor.

The degree requires 120 credit hours, including general education and elective requirements, 27 hours of major-level coursework, and 12 hours of coursework in a cognate field of study.
