## **CERTIFICATIONS**

You will be prepared to seek the Certified Adapted Physical Educator (CAPE) certificate required to be an adapted physical educator in certain states or an add-on endorsement/certificate available in certain states. Contact your state's Department of Education to see if our course work meets state requirements.

You may also take courses for continuing education if you are already CAPE certified or if your state of residence has no certification requirement in adapted physical education.
